## Yummy in My Tummy Review & Giveaway

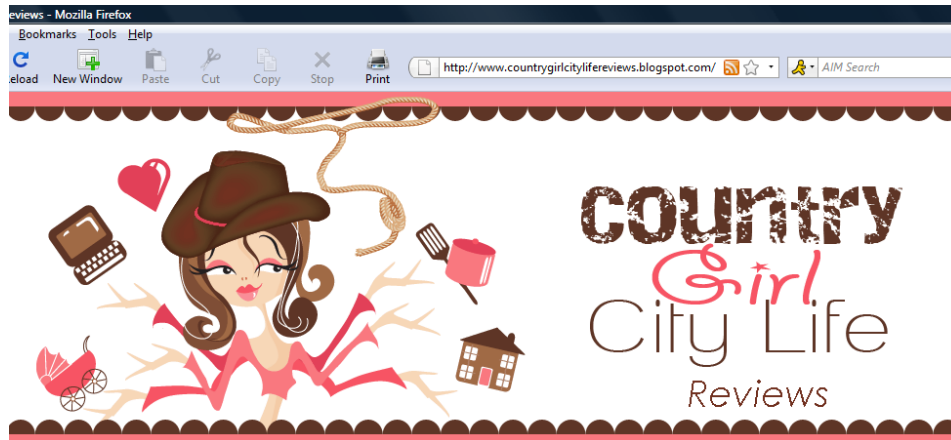

We were offered a sample pack of 24 various food products. They arrived packed in dried



preserve freshness. I was in immediate aww of the cute packaging and brightly colored food. It is important that they eat a variety of colors because each contains a different portion of our daily requirements.



The [food combinations](#) were also exciting to me. I was very excited to offer my little man the carrots and beets, as well as the sweet potato and spinach, as he has never tried those combinations. To my surprise, he loved ALL of the food. They offer seasonal combinations as well.

It is important to keep in mind that because these foods are extremely fresh, they need to be kept refrigerated. They have expiration dates between 2-3 weeks after receiving the product. They are extremely fresh and real tasting, no processed products with a 3 month shelf life!

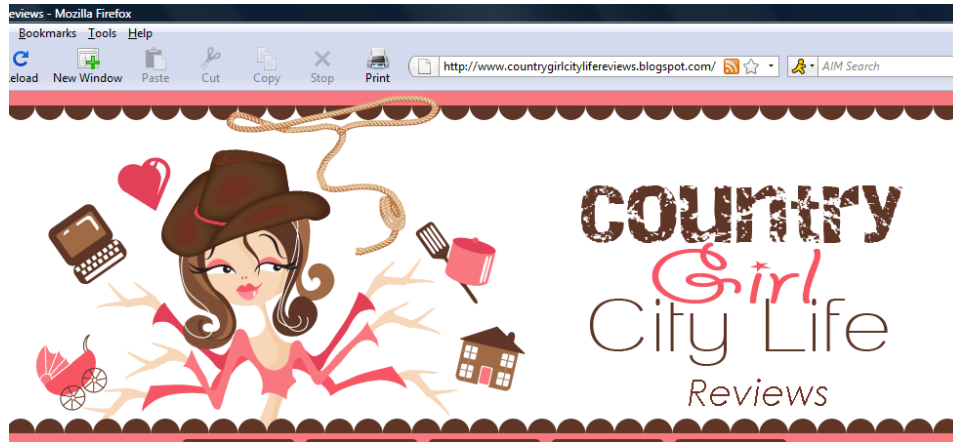

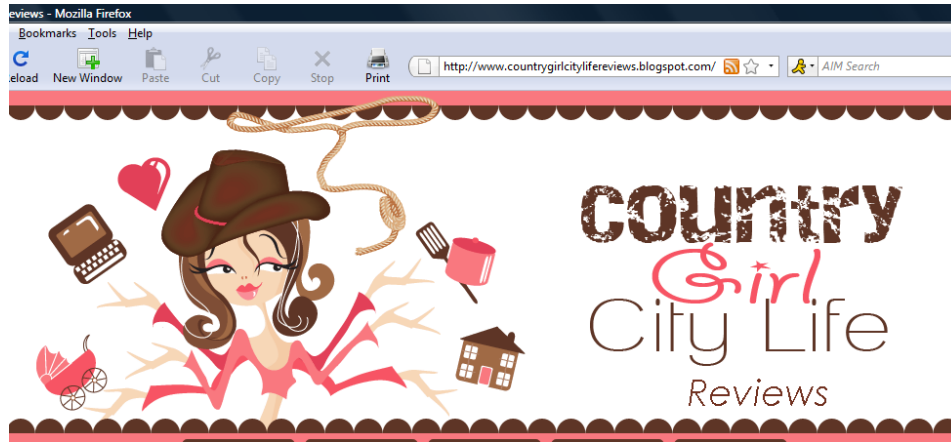
Their retail locations are limited, and shipping can get a little expensive. However, they are working to lower shipping rates and make their fantastic product more readily available nationwide.
